Overview

Representative Matters

Creditors' Representation

Trustee Representation

Rivera (In re Daughtrey)*, 2015 WL 5604764 (M.D. Fla. 2015); *Daughtrey v. Rivera (In re Daughtrey)*, 2018 WL 354007 (11th Cir. 2018). In affirming, the Eleventh Circuit determined, as a matter of apparent first impression in the circuit, the abuse of discretion standard of review applies to a bankruptcy court's denial of a motion to convert a Chapter 7 case to one under Chapter 11.
- Extensive representations of Chapter 7 and Chapter 11 trustees and examiners in multifaceted bankruptcy cases and serves as Chapter 11 trustee, herself.
